The ABC Summer in Construction Program positions students who complete the training to be ready to work in the construction industry with the basic skills necessary.

OVERVIEW

The construction industry is facing a worker shortage. There is a growing demand for young skilled tradespeople as the market is rebounding and many in the field are retiring. Jobs are in high demand and the career opportunities are unlimited. We are currently working with many construction companies that are in need of employees.

This course will provide individuals the opportunity to explore careers in the construction industry. Students that complete this program will receive an OSHA 10 Hour Card, First Aid/CPR/AED/BBP Certification, a minimum of two job interviews, and job skills that can be applied immediately.

The final day of this program will be a "speed interview" day where local contractors and apprenticeship programs will facilitate interviews with the intent to hire/place immediately.

In addition to classroom training, we will provide a hands-on experience throughout the course.
